Subject: Proposal to Implement Gates on Arroyo Grande Creek Levees to Control Vehicle Access

Dear Mr. and Mrs. [REDACTED]

At the next Zone 1/1A Advisory Committee meeting there will be a discussion of possibly making use of existing gates and or constructing new gates at several locations on the Arroyo Grande Creek levees between the Union Pacific Railroad Crossing and the Highway 1 Bridge in order to control vehicle access. Limiting vehicle access to the levees has been recommended in order to prevent illegal dumping on the levees and damage and erosion to levee tops due to vehicle traffic. Because your property is adjacent to the levees at these locations, we are notifying you of the discussion topic so that you may consider attending the meeting if you have questions or concerns regarding the proposal to limit access to the levees.
